



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What is a NOFO?



• The <u>Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)</u> contains

- information about which WPO research programs are
- actively soliciting proposals
- Contains ground rules and
- **key deadlines** for each
- ... funding competition
 - The number of competitions, funding availability, and proposal guidelines **change from year to year**




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What does the NOFO process look like?

NOFO PROCESS SUMMARY


¹WPO program managers work with policy team, partners and stakeholders, and scientific community to develop scientific priorities for each competition within a NOFO.




FY23 NOFO Timeline

What is an LOI?

An LOI, or Letter of Intent is a 2-page research summary that contains a basic project outline, budget, and description of potential outcomes and benefits.

WPO responds with a non-binding recommendation either **encouraging or discouraging** the applicant to proceed with a full proposal.





What is the ACES Survey?

The purpose of the

<u>Applicant Customer Experience &</u> <u>Satisfaction (ACES) Survey</u>


is to <u>gather applicant feedback</u> about WPO's proposal submission/application processes.

A week after the NOFO process was completed in November 2022, WPO launched the ACES Survey. The data collected allows WPO to make informed decisions on <u>how to</u> <u>refine these processes for future</u> competitions.

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



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Finding One: Outreach

Expanding and diversifying applicant demographics








Expand outreach efforts for Minority-Serving Institutions (MSI) and non-traditional research institutions.

- WPO strives for innovative high-risk research that pays off years into the future
- In order for WPO to fund <u>new</u> and <u>innovative</u> scientific research, <u>diversity is necessary</u> within the NOFO applicant pool
- As the scientific field changes, <u>so should the</u> voices being heard and amplified within NOAA






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Finding Two: LOI Feedback

The timeliness, usefulness, and clarity of LOI feedback

Potential Reasons for Lower Ratings

 The Observations and Social, Behavioral, & Economic Sciences (SBES) competitions used a <u>comment menu</u> to deliver feedback


The Comment Menu feedback system provides general and equitable comments, rather than specific feedback for every LOI.

Applicants were frustrated the comment menu **did not provide constructive criticism**, nor specific reasons for the decision to submit a final proposal.

"LOI feedback would have been sincerely appreciated." "I was <u>somewhat discouraged</u> at the <u>Limited</u> <u>feedback provided</u>...for the SBES competition."

"At least two submissions received <u>identical</u>, <u>word-for-word feedback</u>, **but different recommendations** about proceeding with a full proposal."


"The LOI feedback was <u>unhelpful</u>, <u>nonspecific</u>, and <u>directly contradicted</u> what was written in [my] LOI."



Recommendation:

Create a feedback system to address LOI submissions across all competitions in a consistent manner.

- Feedback should <u>provide commentary</u> and/or <u>constructive criticism</u>
- WPO should provide <u>equal opportunities</u> for applicants to receive constructive criticism/ feedback, <u>regardless of competition</u>
- LOI feedback should be constructive and foster an environment which allows researchers to refine and improve their research. This is achieved by **providing consistent feedback** to all applicants





LOI Timing Feedback

• Survey participants indicated they need more time to prepare finalized proposals after receiving LOI feedback

"Ideally having <u>at least another month</u> between LOI feedback and proposal submission is important."

"<u>More time is a must.</u>"

"<u>More time is needed</u> (a) <u>to prepare quality</u> <u>proposals</u> and (b) given other commitments/ <u>things on one's plate that co-occurred with</u> <u>the timing of this proposal</u> (and the timing of any proposal, really)."

"[I recommend] <u>allowing much more</u> <u>time</u> between <u>hearing whether or not</u> <u>an LOI is encouraged</u> and <u>when</u> <u>proposals are due.</u>"

> "Four weeks is really fast given institutional deadlines to have the final packet for review about <u>5 days before the due</u> <u>date</u>."




Recommendation:

Reschedule key dates in the application process timeline to allot applicants at least two more weeks to complete their full proposal after receiving LOI feedback.

- Time crunches and rapidly approaching deadlines <u>force researchers to rush</u> the process of writing/ developing/editing proposals
- WPO should provide enough time for researchers to incorporate feedback provided by LOIs
- Survey participants suggested WPO <u>add an</u> <u>additional two weeks</u> to the NOFO application timeline (a total of six weeks- from LOI feedback receipt to full proposal submission deadline)




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Finding Three: Formatting

Understanding what a full grant proposal should look like



Quotes from Open-Ended Responses

"Perhaps include in the NOFO <u>links</u> <u>to formatting</u>, page limits, and readiness levels."

"The <u>templates were very helpful</u> to me as an <u>early career</u> <u>researcher</u> with <u>no prior experience</u> submitting these."

"It would be **great to have templates** for things like the budget table and budget justification as well."

Formatting Issues

- 36.2% of survey participants had <u>difficulty finding</u> <u>formatting instructions</u> in the NOFO announcement (closed-ended)
- 24.6% of survey participants struggled to understand how to properly format grant proposals (open-ended)

This issue is particularly <u>prominent among</u> applicants from <u>smaller research institutions</u> or <u>first time applicants</u> of a WPO NOFO (26.1% of survey participants).

Recommendation:

Provide a specific layout and/or template for grant proposals (and other documents)on WPO website.



- Allows researchers to <u>visually understand the</u>
 <u>format</u> each competition requires of applications
- Researchers will <u>worry less</u> about correctly formatting proposals and spend <u>more time</u> <u>developing research</u>
- This helps <u>optimize the NOFO application process</u> as researchers write grant proposals, and as WPO reviews proposals
